2021 promises to be an excellent year for local sport and the whole Hammond Park community, with the completion of the Frankland Park Sports and Community Facility, two minutes down the road from Hammond West.

Located on the eastern side of Frankland Park, on the corner of Wattleup Road and Frankland Avenue, this multi-purpose \$9.3 million project will become the official home of the Hammond Park Junior Football Club and Melville Braves Baseball Club – and the unofficial home to countless neighbourhood cricket games, soccer scratch matches, and more.

This fantastic sporting and community facility will include club and function spaces, food and beverage areas, change rooms, toilets, and a 151 spot parking area.

These buildings will allow the local community to make full use of the two AFL size ovals, watered from a bore to ensure it's green all year round, as well as a baseball batting cage, exercise equipment, and a terraced retaining wall to give spectators somewhere to sit and enjoy the action. Best of all, the LED floodlighting means people can make the most of an incredible facility.

As the Hammond Park area has continued its rapid development over the last few years, it became apparent that there was a lack of public open space. Frankland Park's development is a welcome addition to the local amenities, ensuring the growing community's sport and recreation needs are met.
